

# SVU TeniSTA Wintersport 2024

The SVU TeniSTA Wintersport 2024 will take place from the 29th of February until the 5th of March. In this document, you will find all important information for the trip, so please read it carefully!

## Travel

We have our own touring car which will bring us to and from our destination in Alpendorf, Austria. We depart early in the evening on Thursday and will travel overnight to our accommodation. Upon arrival, we will quickly drop our luggage at the hotel so that we can immediately start our first day on the slopes (even if you rent equipment!!). On Monday we will have a last full day on the slopes, after which we will directly go back to the bus and depart home.

## Ski Area

The ski area Snow Space Salzburg consists of multiple connected ski areas with a total of more than 210 km slopes. It is particularly suitable for beginners due to the number of blue slopes, but for experienced skiers there are enough challenging black slopes. It is also a snow-sure area. ## Accommodation

We will be hosted by Pension Waldhof in Alpendorf. We will make and share the exact room plan later. The accommodation will provide breakfast on Saturday, Sunday and Monday, so bring your own breakfast (and lunch) for Friday! Lunch is something that is up to you to arrange for yourself on each day. We will also have dinner in the pension on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. On Monday evening we will stop at a highway service area, to give everyone the opportunity to find something to eat there.

## Local transport

Our accommodation is at a 5 minute driving distance from the nearest ski lifts. We have our own transport bringing us each morning and picking us up at the end of each day at fixed times, possibly at different starting locations each day. There also is a free public local ski bus, in case someone wants to have a transfer at a different time.

## Equipment

For everyone that is renting equipment from Huski, we will organise a fitting day where the right equipment can be chosen. Make sure to be present, otherwise the only opportunity to fit is at another fixed time in Houten, where this company is based. If you did not use the fitting session, you will get materials that you have not fitted before at your own risk.

- *If you have your own skiing-shoes, but are renting skis:*  
Please bring your shoes to the fitting session and hand them in. The renting company will take them in order to adjust the skis accordingly and preload them into the bus before departure. If you do not hand in your shoes, you will need to arrange yourself upon arrival that your skis are set correctly, at your own risk and potential cost.
- *If you have your own snowboard-shoes, but are renting a board:*  
You can bring your shoes to the fitting session and show them to the renting company, in order to verify they will provide a board with the right straps. You do not leave your shoes behind.
- *If you have your own skis, but are renting shoes:*  
Please consider using rental skis instead of your own (this has no additional costs). If you bring your own skis, the company cannot adjust them to the rented shoes. You would need to arrange yourself upon arrival that your skis are set correctly, at your own risk and potential cost.

**The fitting day will take place on Tuesday the 23th of January at 18:15 around Uilenstede. Make sure to arrive on time, because the rental company will not wait for you.**

Price:

- €28 for skies & shoes or €38 for snowboard & shoes
- €10 for a helmet (if you don't have one yourself, rent it. You really need one)

## Sign up

Then the most important question that remains: How to sign up?

1. Go to [tenista.nl/posts/wintersport-2024](https://tenista.nl/posts/wintersport-2024) and fill out the form.
2. Transfer the total amount of **€594,- + potential rental costs** to NL80 INGB 0005 4483 31 t.a.v. SVU TeniSTA.

The deadline for sign up is 23 December, but FULL=FULL so be on time.

## Travel Insurance

Finally, we want to remind you **it is very important to have a travel insurance that includes winter sports!** Also if you already have a continuous travel insurance, please double check if skiing/snowboarding is included, because this is often a separate option that needs to be activated separately.
